



Nuneaton Junior Open 18 Hole Medal Rules

1. The 18 hole medal competition is open to Junior members of recognised golf clubs, who are aged 18 and under on 1st January of the year played.
2. Maximum WHS handicap limit for entry is 36.
3. The Junior Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without having to give a reason.
4. Payment for entry into the competition will be taken on the day.
5. The competition committee reserves the right to fix/alter starting times.
6. Competitors must conform to the Rules of Golf as approved by The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the local rules of Nuneaton Golf Club.
7. All ties will be decided by the 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes of the card.
8. Play will be off the Yellow Tees for boys and Red Tees for girls.
9. All disputes shall be decided by the Junior Committee whose decision will be final.
10. Nuneaton Golf Club cannot accept responsibility for thefts and accidents and competitors must carry their own insurance.
11. Competitors must protect themselves in Health and Safety matters, especially should there be a danger from lightning, when play must stop immediately and not be resumed until the danger has passed.
12. If the storm warning siren sounds, play must stop immediately and players must return to the Clubhouse
13. Competitors must comply with any further conditions advised on the day of the competition.
14. Prize structure will be notified to all entrants prior to the event.
15. Caddies are not allowed.
