

Nuneaton Junior Open 18 Hole Medal Rules

- 1. The 18 hole medal competition is open to Junior members of recognised golf clubs, who are aged 18 and under on 1st January of the year played.
- 2. Maximum WHS handicap limit for entry is 36.
- 3. The Junior Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without having to give a reason.
- 4. Payment for entry into the competition will be taken on the day.
- 5. The competition committee reserves the right to fix/alter starting times.
- 6. Competitors must conform to the Rules of Golf as approved by The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the local rules of Nuneaton Golf Club.
- 7. All ties will be decided by the 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes of the card.
- 8. Play will be off the Yellow Tees for boys and Red Tees for girls.
- 9. All disputes shall be decided by the Junior Committee whose decision will be final.
- 10. Nuneaton Golf Club cannot accept responsibility for thefts and accidents and competitors must carry their own insurance.
- 11. Competitors must protect themselves in Health and Safety matters, especially should there be a danger from lightning, when play must stop immediately and not be resumed until the danger has passed.
- 12. If the storm warning siren sounds, play must stop immediately and players must return to the Clubhouse
- 13. Competitors must comply with any further conditions advised on the day of the competition.
- 14. Prize structure will be notified to all entrants prior to the event.
- 15. Caddies are not allowed.
